

# TTBC Mad Dog Rules

- **Stock Dog**
  - 2-valve, air-cooled, 4-stroke
  - 156cc or less (stock bore & stroke)
  - Normally aspirated motor - no turbo, supercharger, etc.
  - Knobby tires allowed
  - Stock motor
  - Stock carb
  - Stock airbox (mods allowed)
  - Stock frame
  - Stock wheels
  - Stock electronics
  - Aftermarket exhaust allowed
  - Must be stock from the beginning of the carb to the end of the exhaust port
  - No methanol
- **Mad Dog**
  - 2-valve, air-cooled, 4-stroke
  - Motor must originate as 156cc or less
  - Any bore and stroke up to 175cc, TTR125 allowed 185cc with OEM head (head can be modified)
  - Normally aspirated motor - no turbo, supercharger, etc.
  - No rear knobby tires (front knobby allowed)
  - Any frame and motor combination allowed
  - Maximum wheel sizes: 19" front, 17" rear
  - No methanol
- **Mad Pup**
  - Age 12 & under
  - Up to 110cc 4-stroke
  - Up to 50cc 2-stroke
  - Maximum wheel sizes: 14" front, 12" rear
  - Stock Dog class rules apply otherwise
- **Mad Pup Unlimited**
  - Age 12 & under
  - Up to 156cc 4-stroke
  - Up to 65cc 2-stroke
  - Mad Dog class rules apply otherwise

# TTBC Mad Dog Classes

The TTBC Mad Dog class structure consists of Beginner, Mad Pup, Novice, Intermediate and Pro.

- **Beginner:** Someone who has never raced before, or only a few times. A Beginner may also race up into the Novice class.  
**Classes a Beginner can race:**
  - Beginner Class
  - Stock Dog (Beginners can race this class regardless of bike configuration, as long as it fits Mad Dog rules)
  - Mad Dog Novice
- **Mad Pup:** Anyone age 12 and under. A Mad Pup can also race up into the Novice class.  
**Classes a Mad Pup can race:**
  - Mad Pup 110cc or less
  - Mad Pup Unlimited
  - Mad Dog Novice
  - Stock Dog (bike must be within Stock Dog rules)
- **Novice:** A Novice can also race up into the Intermediate class.  
**Classes a Novice can race:**
  - Mad Dog Novice
  - Mad Dog Intermediate
  - Salty Dog
  - Young Dog/Millennial Dog/Old Dog depending upon age
  - Stock Dog (bike must be within Stock Dog rules)
- **Intermediate:** An Intermediate can also race up into the Pro class.  
**Classes an Intermediate can race:**
  - Mad Dog Intermediate
  - Mad Dog Pro
  - Salty Dog
  - Young Dog/Millennial Dog/Old Dog depending upon age
  - Stock Dog (bike must be within Stock Dog rules)
- **Pro:** If you are considered a Pro, you cannot race down a class.  
**Classes a Pro can race:**
  - Mad Dog Pro
  - Salty Dog
  - Young Dog/Millennial Dog/Old Dog depending upon age

# TTBC Mad Dog Classes - Cont.

## Classes

- **Mad Dog Pro** (Intermediate and Pro) - 100% Payback
  - **Mad Dog Intermediate** (Novice and Intermediate) - Trophies
  - **Mad Dog Novice** (Beginner, Novice and Mad Pup) - Trophies
  - **Salty Dog** (Novice, Intermediate and Pro) - 50% Payback
  - **Young Dog** 34 and under (Novice, Intermediate and Pro) - Trophies
  - **Millennial Dog** 35+ (Novice, Intermediate and Pro) - Trophies
  - **Old Dog** 45+ (Novice, Intermediate and Pro) - Trophies
  - **Stock Dog** Bike must fall within Stock Dog rules (Beginner, Novice, Intermediate and Mad Pup) - Trophies
  - **Mad Pup** 12 and under, bike must meet Mad Pup rules - Trophies
  - **Mad Pup Unlimited** 12 and under, bike must meet Mad Pup Unlimited rules - Trophies
  - **Beginner** True beginner racers only - Trophies
  - **Stacyc** - Medals

- Mad Dog Pro: \$40 online pre-entry, \$50 post-entry (day of)
  - Non-Pro Classes: \$30 online pre-entry, \$40 post-entry (day of)
  - Beginner, Mad Pup and Mad Pup Unlimited: \$10
  - Stacyc Class: Free!
  - \$10 gate fee applies to anyone who enters the gate, racers included (8 and under are free).
  - All classes will run heat races and a main event. Large turnouts could also lead to an LCQ or B-main.
  - All classes are Mad Dog rules, except for Mad Pup, and Stock Dog.
  - Heat race grids will be determined by the order of sign up.
  - We have the ability to check displacement if needed.
  - The Race Director will have the final say in what class you race (Beginner, Novice, Intermediate or Pro). Sandbaggers are frowned upon!
